

## **Procedures for Keeping The Pool Open After Hours**

Members can request the pool stay open after normal operating hours (per contract between Crystal Aquatics, Inc., and Fairfax Club Estates Homeowners Association Board of Directors). The following guidance applies to all these requests:

- ↵ Members must obtain approval to keep the pool open after hours from the Manager on Duty. Once approved by the Manager on duty, the Manager must make an entry into the logbook/reservation book.
- ↵ The pool cannot be closed during normal operating hours for a private party. However, once normal operating hours have ended, all members not associated with the private party must leave (unless otherwise stated by the member responsible for the private party)
- ↵ Only one pavilion can be reserved at any one time. Under no circumstances during normal operating hours will two pavilions be reserved at the same time.
- ↵ The member must provide a check to the Manager on duty on the night of the private party. The check is to be made out to FCE HOA. The cost is \$26.50/hour for the Pool Operator/Manager and \$19.50/hour for each lifeguard.
  - o For private parties under 10 people: A Manager and lifeguard are required.
  - o For private parties greater than 10 people, a Manager and two Lifeguards are required
- ↵ Private parties must end by 11:00 pm. This is to 1) Avoid problems with noise (see Code of Fairfax County Noise Ordinance), 2) Respect neighbors near the pool right to quiet, and 3) allow the Manager/lifeguards to travel home before midnight. **NO EXCEPTIONS WILL BE MADE TO THIS RULE.**
